ROSTERED MINISTERS DEPARTING COVENANT

It has been my privilege to serve the mission and ministry of First Luthevan Church Church/Parish as Pastor/Deacon during these past 2 yews 5% months/years. As God called me for a time to serve among you, God now calls me forth to serve in a new way, in a new place among a new people though still one in the body of Christ.

In prayerful conversation with the Congregation/Parish Council of First Lutwer an Clay have discussed the policies and expectations of the Northwestern Minnesota Synod of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America, and I enter into the following covenant.

I agree:

- to pray for the ongoing mission of the congregation and for their new rostered minister;
- to communicate to the congregation, in writing and in conversation, the terms of the covenant, which terminates this called relationship;
- to not be involved in any leadership or advisory role (public or private) in this congregation and to refrain from behaviors that seek in any way to control the transition process, including any attempt to influence the choice of a successor:
- to refrain from language or behavior that could undermine the development of therelationship between the congregation and a new rostered leader (interim or successor), including social media;
- to refuse to offer support or advice to anyone involved in a congregational disagreement;
- to refuse requests for pastoral services made by members of the congregation, including baptisms, weddings, funerals, anniversaries, visiting the sick and homebound;
- to consult with the current rostered minister regarding my attendance at worship and special events;
- to encourage my family members to support me in maintaining this covenant and to support the ministry of the congregation's new rostered minister.

(Other items may be added that are consistent with the particular relationship and mission of this congregation).

It is understood that this covenant does not affect or require termination of friendships with individuals who are members of this congregation.





In OTC there is a shortage of 323 starter, single family homes. HABITAT FOR HUMANITY'S goal is to alleviate much of the stress this causes and to help extremely low-income people find a way to own a modest home in which to live and raise their families.

We at FLC can help! We are blessed to know God's love for ALL His children, and Jesus has directed us to respond to the needs of His "flock". Exterior doors for a habitat house cost about \$3,000 which is an attainable goal. We have



Audits & Accountability

In May the finance committee arranged an audit of the 2023 books. We'd like to thank the audit team for their work in making sure our financials are in order.

Here is their report...

Finance Committee Members,

As requested, audit team members met with the Church Administrator on May 21, 2024 to conduct an audit of the church's 2023 financial materials. In accordance with provided FLC Audit Guidelines, team members:

- evaluated no fewer than two months of account reconciliations,
- confirmed two signatures on checks over \$2,500,
- reviewed weekly offering counts for two sampled months to validate deposit amounts and confirm two individuals verified the count prior to deposit,
- reviewed special account records and traced a sample of deposits to confirm correct fund allocations,
- discussed current payroll processes and responsibilities for church-affiliated accounts with the Church Administrator.

During the review, the Church Administrator was knowledgeable and readily able to answer team member questions. Further, team members involved in prior audits of the church finances noted improved levels of quality and transparency in the available records. Based on this review, we believe there is reasonable assurance the processes reviewed are operating as intended.

Exterior Brick Repair

You may have noticed that the plaster is coming away from the walls in a few places in the sanctuary. It turns out that the brick exterior is actually the problem. It needs to be tuckpointed and sealed which is an expensive endeavor. The property committee has met with a contractor to make a plan for these repairs. Church Council has authorized spending \$20,000 from the Building Improvement Fund to address the worst area first which is on the northwest wall of the choir transcept. These repairs will begin late this summer. Once the outside is repaired we can move on to repairing the plaster.



FLC Cemeteries


